BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT

For those of you who have contributed to this project by sponsoring trees etc., please be patient & Thank You for your support with this project!! We are moving forward!

The state requires a number of things to happen before we can actually break ground and their timeline is very drawn out! In April of 2008, we were informed of acceptance for this project by the State. In June 2008, we had our pre-agreement meeting with the State. From here, we are awaiting drawings from a licensed Landscape Architect Engineer and letter from the Historical Commission (which we have) Army Corps of Engineers and the Fish & Wildlife Department and again from Alabama Railroad. Once these letters are obtained, projected to receive by mid February, the State then has to put its stamp once again on the final plans with these supporting documents, projected timeline (if we all pray hard) mid March 2009. At such time bids will go out for advertising for approximate 21 days. Once bids are opened, lowest bid will be chosen and approved by State and work can commence.

The State of Alabama informed me in June not to expect to break ground for at least 12 to 18 months. We are, however, hopeful that we can speed things up and be finished by Fall of 2009. We have ordered an Historical Plaque to mount in an appropriate spot onsite with all the contributors names. This has actually been given to us at no cost by the "Year of Alabama Small Towns" Project. This will not arrive until 2010. We have checked into individual plaques for each tree or even each trio of trees but so far each plaque will cost approx. \$185 each. So you can see that this would not be feasible. We are still looking so that if by some miracle we can identify trees individually for those who contributed we will.
